The division of Masonry into 3 symbolic degrees</li> <li>3. The symbolic legend of <u>Hiram Abiff</u></li> <li>4. The government of the fraternity by a <u>Grand Master</u></li> <li>5. The prerogative of the Grand Master to preside over every assembly of the craft</li> <li>6. The prerogative of the Grand Master to issue dispensations for conferring degrees at irregular times</li> <li>7. The prerogative of the Grand Master to issue dispensations for opening and holding Lodges otherwise not established</li> <li>8. The prerogative of the Grand Master to make <u>Masons at Sight</u></li> <li>9. The necessity for Masons to congregate in Lodges</li> <li>10. The government of Lodges to be by a <u>Master</u> and two Wardens</li> <li>11. The necessity that every Lodge when congregated be duly <u>tiled</u></li> <li>12. The right of every Mason to be represented in all general meetings of the Craft</li> <li>13. The right of every Mason to appeal from his Lodge's decisions to the Grand Lodge</li> <li>14. The right of every Mason to sit in every regular Lodge</li> <li>15. That no unknown visitor be allowed to sit in Lodge without being examined and found to be a Freemason</li> <li>16. That no Lodge can interfere in the business of another Lodge</li> <li>17. That every Freemason be amenable to the laws and regulations of the Jurisdiction in which he resides</li> <li>18. That candidates for Freemasonry be required to meet certain qualifications; namely: being a man, of mature age, not a cripple, and free born.</li> <li>19. That a belief in the existence of God be a requirement for membership</li> <li>20. That belief in a resurrection to a future life be a requirement for membership</li> <li>21. That a "Book of the Law" shall constitute an indispensable part of the furniture of every Lodge</li> <li>22. The equality of Masons<sup>(a)</sup></li> <li>23. The secrecy of the Institution</li> <li>24. The foundation of a speculative science upon an operative art, and the symbolic use and explanation of the terms of that art for purposes of moral teaching</li> <li>25.
