

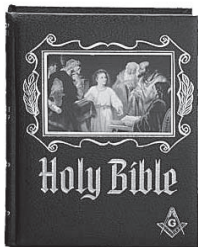

I would like to share a story on the Masonic fellowship that really shows who we are as a fraternity. Two weeks ago I made my first night time emergency room visit with my two year old daughter. This is obviously a stressful time for anyone, and many times you expect to be treated in a mechanical type fashion. A short time into the visit, I made mention to myself how great we were being treated. The hospital staff literally made the experience a pleasurable one, especially given the unfortunate circumstances.

One male nurse in particular came in to check on us every 10 minutes and always bringing something for my daughter to keep her comfortable. I could hear him at the nurses station making sure the doctor filled out the paperwork in a timely manner and calling the lab to ensure our tests be made a priority. A short time later we were given good news and sent on our way. As we were leaving, I was thanking the hospital staff for the best treatment I had ever received. When I shook hands with the nurse I knew we were brothers. He smiled and said "you have lots of brothers here".

I'm not advocating that we give preferential treatment just because someone is a brother, but it's nice to know that one was looking out for me in a time of need.
